**POLICY 3 - TOOL SALE**

PAW may have a tool sale once a year during a general meeting to allow members to sell items that they no longer want or need.

**Section 1. Sale Items**

Bring tools or items relating to woodturning that you want to sell (sanders, turning tools, tool holders, routers, drills, grinders, etc.). Photographs of larger items will suffice, such as, lathes, bandsaws, etc.

**Section 2. Setup and Preview**

Tool preview will take place before the meeting during set up of the tools to be sold.

**Section 3. Requirements**

1. Only current members are eligible to participate.
2. All tools must be in working order, unless otherwise noted.
3. All tools must be labeled with the owner's name and price.

**Section 4. Payment**

Payment is directly between the buyer and the owner/seller.

**Section 5. Procedure**

1. Each member must sign in to get a buyer's number, or a ticket, to be randomly drawn.
2. When a participants' number or ticket is drawn he or she can buy whatever is displayed in the sale area.
3. Once your number or ticket is drawn you will have 3 minutes to select your purchases. (Hint - Come early and preview the items for sale)
4. Once all numbers or tickets have cycled through the draw then the sale will go to open bidding and trading if any items remain for sale.

**Section 6. Barter and Trade**

Those lucky members who get an early draw might be open to an offer or trade.
